

ENGLISH PASTOR (Full time position)

The English Pastor is called predominantly to minister the English congregation and build up the well-developed spiritual lives of worshippers through preaching, relevant teaching, training and pastoral care-giving.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Theological Education: Graduated from an accredited evangelical seminary.

Doctrine: Consistent with WBC's "Mission Statement" and "Statements of Basic Beliefs".

Language: English. Able to communicate in Cantonese or Mandarin is an asset.

Spiritual Maturity: Have a godly character of an overseer and elder as defined in 1 Tim.3:1-7 and

Titus 1:6-9

Leadership: Able to lead and develop others to grow in Christ.

Evangelism: Able and willing to reach the unsaved and lead them to Christ.

Communication Skills: Strong preaching and teaching abilities.

Interpersonal Skills: Work harmoniously, and have a healthy and caring relationship with people in a

multi-cultural, multi-lingual and multi-generational church.

Exception: 3+ years of pastoral experience in North America is preferred Exceptional candidates not completely qualified may also apply for

consideration.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Oversee the English Ministry and regularly report to the Senior Pastor on ministry progress.
- Develop, implement and apply the church vision to the English speaking congregation.
- Serve as a spiritual leader to lead and shepherd the English speaking individuals and families.
- Under the guidance of the Senior Pastor, integrate the English ministry into the Wismer family.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Disciple and mentor the English congregants. Assist them in following God's call in their lives.
- Preach and teach in worship services and Sunday school.
- Develop servant-leaders and counsel all the fellowships and committees.
- Oversee and shepherd the regular ministry programs and special events.
- Care for and visit the English speaking individuals and families
- Evangelize and reach out to the community and neighbourhood.
- Attend and actively participate in the church and ministry related meetings including Members meeting, Deacon Board meeting, Ministry Council meeting, pastoral staff meeting, prayer meeting, etc. as needed.
- Perform other duties as required under the direction of the Senior Pastor.
